GENERAL COVID GUIDELINES

- Wash Hands Often
- Scrub In & Out with hand sanitizer at each activity.
- RSR will operate at 50% occupancy of indoor spaces especially in the Dining Hall, Riley-Wallace and Heritage Hall.
- Masks are optional while outdoors
- Campers/Guests are encouraged to remain together with their Group assigned Cabin Group or Family Unit during your stay at RSR, to the largest extent possible
 - Note: The CDC, KDHE and ACA are still recommending masking indoors when multiple Cabin Groups, Family Units or RSR Staff Pods are together as well as outdoors when social distancing less than 6 feet may occur for more than 10 minutes
- RSR is providing extra Bottle Fill, Handwashing & Sanitation Stations with enhanced facilities ventilation and disinfection of commons on a daily basis
- RSR will continue to expect Campers/Guests who become symptomatic, learn of a positive COVID exposure or test to quarantine on site until they can return home within 6 hours

DINING HALL COVID GUIDELINES (Please listen for and follow Dining Room Supervisor Instructions)

- All Campers/Guests/Staff, please wash your hands as you line up for meals at one of these locations:
 - Upper Dining Hall patio at the "Canoe"
 - Upper Dining Hall Lobby Restrooms
 - Lower Dining Hall Restrooms just inside the door to the left across from the Indoor Activity Center
- Masks are required for all, regardless of vaccination status, when entering the Dining Hall, picking up food from the serving area and when exiting the building.
- All are encouraged to sit with their assigned Cabin Group, Family Unit or Staff Pod. Please listen for and follow Dining Hall Staff instructions. We will be filling tables from back to front or vice versa depending on the section of the Dining Hall to assist with social distancing.
- Campers/Guests may have their masks off while seated at their table eating and conversing.
- Tables will be dismissed by the Dining Room Staff. KPs will remain awaiting cleanup instructions.
